## **Royal Holloway University Of London Open Day**

The summer term of Year 12 is a great opportunity to look at careers options and the array of pathways beyond Sixth Form.

As a part of this program Year 12 Students will be attending an open day at Royal Holloway University in Egham, Surrey. The open day offers an informative and interactive experience of the University through talks, zones and tours.
