



Allocation of Places at Brakenhale School September 2018

There are 210 places available for students who will join Year 7 at Brakenhale School in September 2018. The closing date for the Supplementary Information Form was 31 October 2017. By this date, 467 applications had been received for consideration by the Admissions Panel.

The school is therefore oversubscribed and, in line with the published Admissions Arrangements, the Admissions Panel of the Governing Board has allocated places according to the criteria published in the booklet 'Guide to Secondary Education in Bracknell Forest' and in the Brakenhale School Admissions Arrangements which were given to parents/carers in September 2017.

The following table sets out the number of applicants in each category:

SEN (children with an Educational Health Care Plan)	2
Priority 1 (looked after children)	3
Priority 2 (social & medical)	1
Priority 3 (designated area)	165
Priority 4 (children of staff members)	1
Priority 5 (children with siblings)	16
Priority 6 (distance)	22

2 children with a Statement of Special Educational Needs, 3 LAC and 1 social and medical application have been awarded a statutory place leaving a further 204 places to be allocated by the Governing Board.

Applicants have been considered against the categories as set out in the Admissions Arrangements and ranked by category. The first 208 ranked applicants have been offered a place.

Those applicants who have not been offered a place have been automatically placed in ranked order on a waiting list, which will be maintained until the end of the Autumn Term 2018. From this list, offers of a place will be made, in order of priority, to fill any places which are not taken up. After that time applicants may indicate that they wish to remain on the waiting list for the remainder of the academic year 2018 - 2019. A new application will need to be made for each subsequent academic year to be placed on the waiting list.
